NOTE: Athletes may only warm up in a session in which they are scheduled to compete.
Presidents may warm up with the first block in order to attend the president's meeting at 9am.

Meet Warmup Procedures

Prelims Sessions

The south and north pools will be open for general warmup during the scheduled times only, with lanes being assigned to each club. The dive well will be continuously open throughout the prelim sessions for warm up/warm down in addition to during the warmup session as open warmups. Any warmup time changes will be announced in presidents' meetings and through the Central Regionals Discord channel.

Facility Information (Updated 11/5/25) -

A 25-meter warm-up pool will be available for warm-up and cool-down during the prelims

- Swimmers are expected to utilize this pool only to warm-up and cool-down.
- Only pace and circle swimming will be permitted in the warm-up pool.
- NO EQUIPMENT is permitted in the warm-up pool. This means no fins, paddles, kickboards, pull buoys, parachutes, or assistive swimming/bungee cord pulls. Snorkels and goggles are permitted.
- Horseplay is NOT permitted. Swimmers should only swim back and forth. No diving to the bottom of the diving well. No breath holding exercises for full lengths of the pool or hanging out under water.
- Entries into the warm-up pool should be feet first with one hand on the pool deck. Diving is NOT permitted.
- Do not block the view of lifeguards. Swimmers may not stand in front of guard chairs and should sit on the parapet (not stand) until they are ready to hop in.
- Respect the bather load. We aim to keep 14 people or less in each lane (so we do not exceed capacity and guards can observe all swimmers). If a lane is full, wait for two people to exit the lane before entering the pool.

Finals Sessions

The south pool will be open for general warmup during the scheduled times only, and the north pool will be continuously open for warm up from the beginning of the warmup session and throughout the session. Teams will not be assigned warm up time slots for finals. Any warm up time changes will be announced in presidents' meetings and through the Central Regionals Discord channel.

Assigned Team Seating

Teams are assigned to seating areas, either on the pool deck bleachers or in the spectator stands area. If assigned to the pool deck, teams will be given a specific bleacher which may be shared with other teams. Teams will be given their assigned seating information in their check-in packet and it can also be found in this packet.

Clerk of Course

The Clerk of Course desk will be located next to the head operations table near the starting blocks of the south pool. All final scratches must be declared to the Clerk of Course table within 30 minutes of the results being posted and announced.

Awards Presentation Schedule

Awards will be presented right after the A final of each men's event. The top 3 athletes in each event need to be ready to receive their award following the conclusion of the men's A final. For example, the top three finishers in the 100 breaststroke for men and women will receive their award at the conclusion of the men's 100 breaststroke A final.

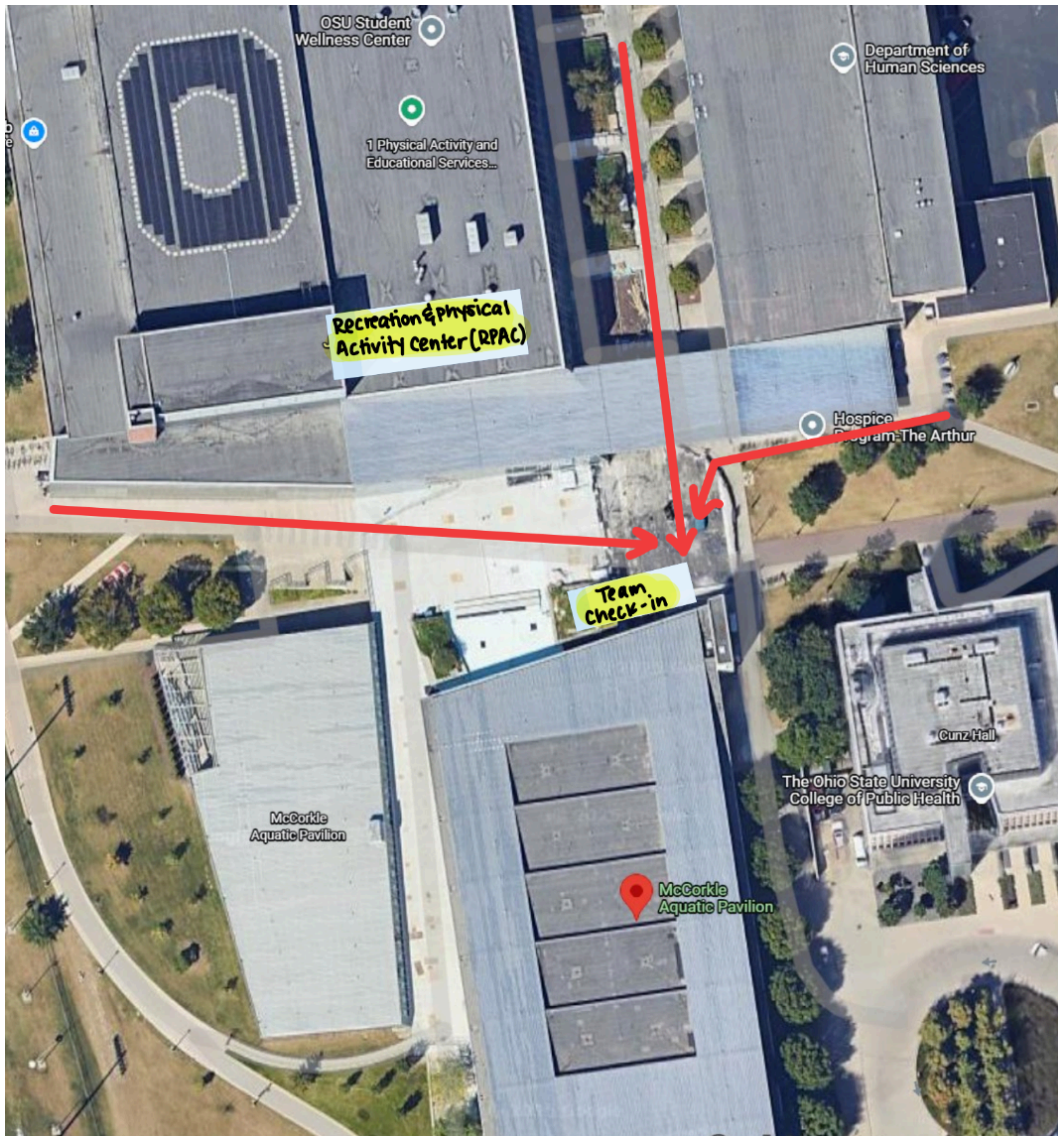
Update 11/5/25: Awards for events swum in the prelims sessions as timed finals (200 Butterfly/Backstroke/Breaststroke, 400 IM, 500 and 1000 Freestyle) will be presented 15 minutes prior to the start of the Finals session on the day that they are swum.

Team awards will be presented at the conclusion of the Sunday Finals session.

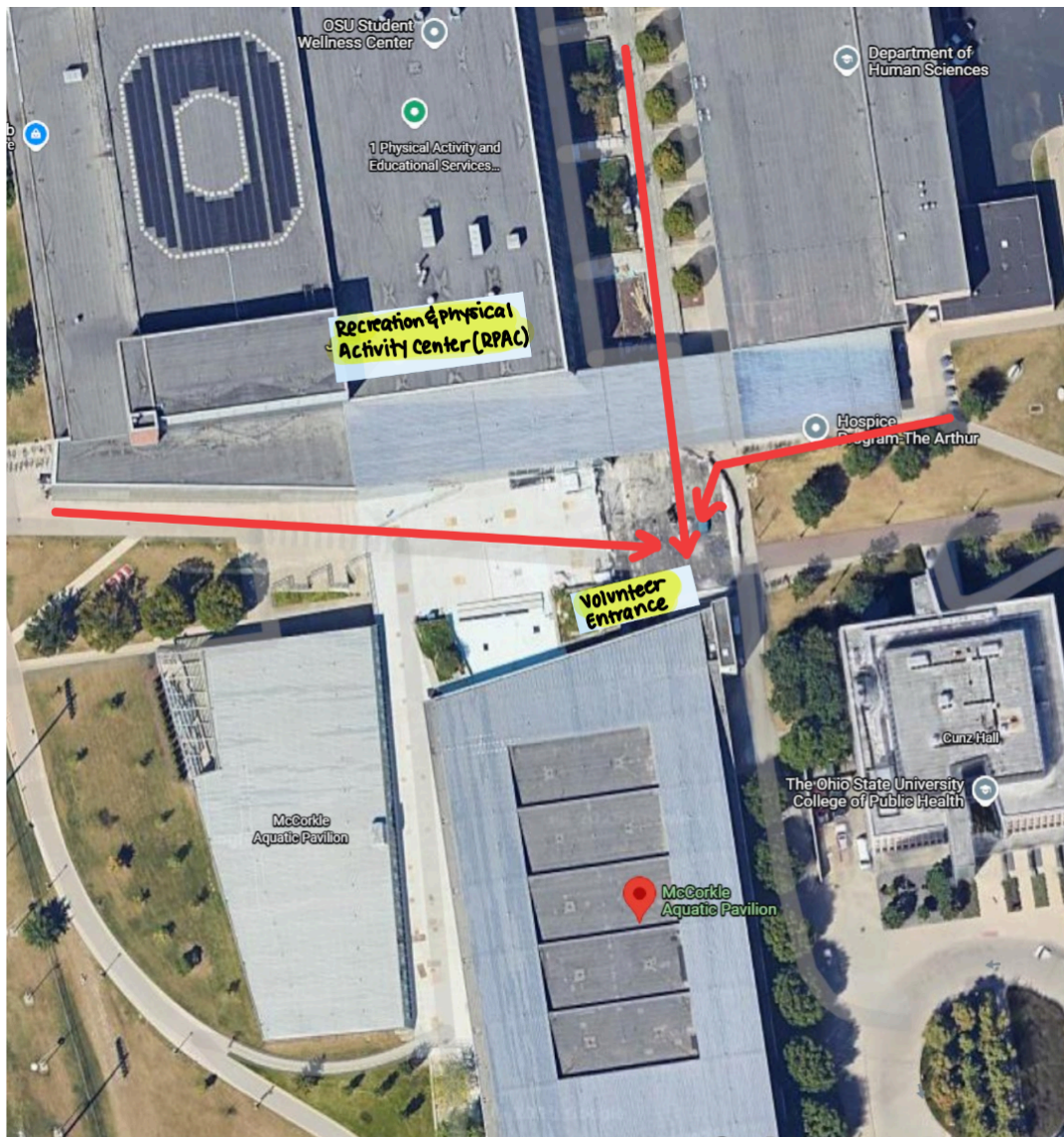
Facility Policies & Logistics

- Please keep all trash picked up in your team and spectator seating areas and stay away from restricted areas. If a swimmer is found in a restricted area, the swimmer will be asked to leave the facility and may be pulled from the remainder of the meet.
- Vandalism will not be tolerated. Any individual caught vandalizing the facility will be asked to leave the facility for the remainder of this meet.
- Deck access is restricted to competing athletes, registered coaches, officials, event staff, and meet volunteers. No parents, spectators, or members of the general public will be allowed on deck except at the request of a Meet Director or Meet Referee.
- Belongings should be removed from the deck between sessions and overnight for cleaning.
- No tape is allowed in the tile area for hanging team banners or any other use. Zip ties and bungee cords are acceptable for this purpose.
- The Ohio State University is a smoke-free campus.
- The McCorkle Aquatic Pavillion will be open for regular patrons throughout the weekend. With that in mind, note that the RPAC is not available to athletes competing in the meet, excluding the locker rooms.
- The lost & found is located on the pool deck by the lifeguard room.
- If your team is planning on ordering food delivered to the McCorkle Aquatic Pavillion, please ensure the order has the club name listed and that someone is ready to receive it when it arrives.
- Noise makers of any kind are not permitted within the facility.
- Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits (except for drag suits) other than in locker rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited within the venue (pools, athletic/coaches' areas, spectator areas and, if present, open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Helium balloons are not permitted in the facility.
- Pets, other than documented service animals, are prohibited.
- Lockers are reserved for OSU Recreational Sports Members only. Items should be stored in team areas on the deck and seating areas. The university is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Footwear must be worn in the upper level of the Aquatic Pavilion and all areas outside of the pool deck and locker rooms.

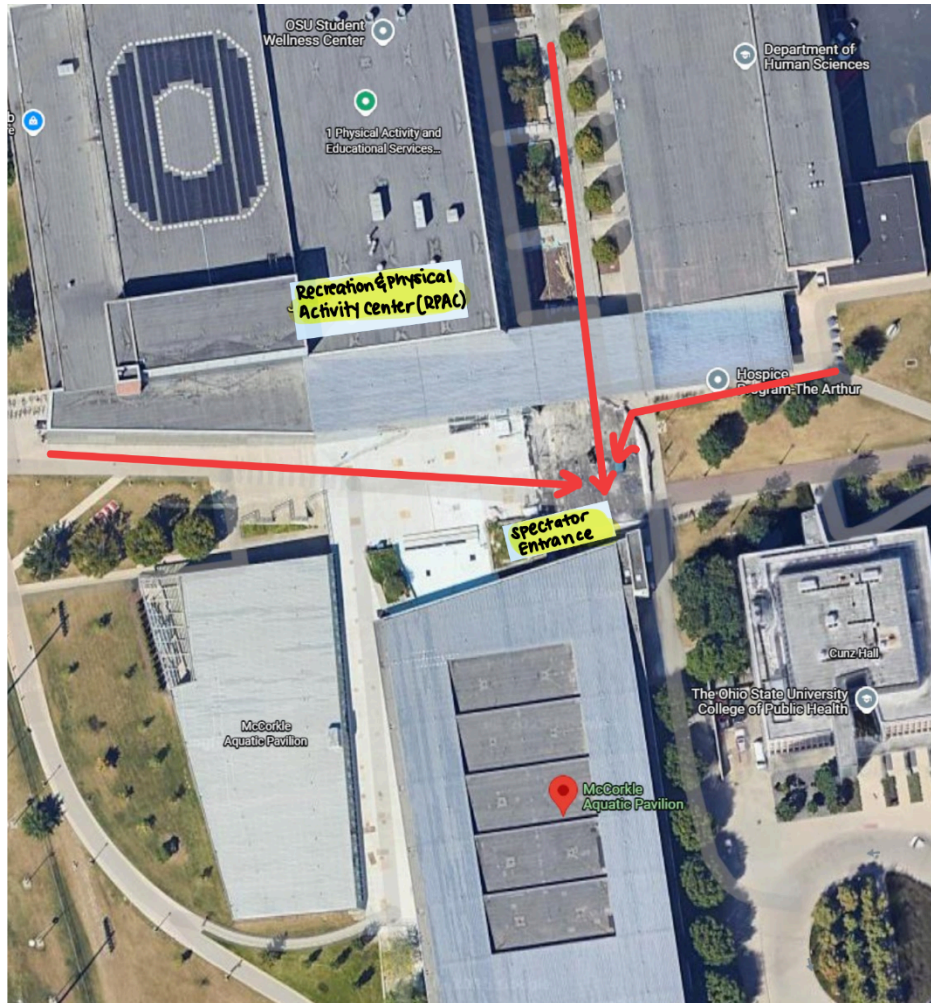


All volunteers should plan on checking in **at least 15 minutes** prior to the start of their shift. Further directions will be given to volunteers upon arrival.

Check-in Procedures

As is noted in the Meet Information Packet, you must check in prior to the first session in which your team has athletes competing. **No athletes may enter the facility until they have received their credentials**, which teams receive at check-in. Check-in will be available from 5:00 PM - 8:00 PM, Friday November 7th. We highly recommend your team checks in during this time, but for teams unable to make this, teams may also check-in from 7:45 am until the start of Saturday prelims at the pool entrance. Anyone checking in after this time should contact the meet directors, Bianca (513-807-0100) or Sean (513-372-4102), to check in.

Please bring a printed or digital copy of your receipt showing payment of your swimming entry fees through CCS/Club Assistant (the registration software) or proof that payment is in process. **If you do not provide a receipt or proof of in-process payment, your team will be unable to check in and will be unable to enter the pool deck.**

All athletes from each team must fill out the following waiver. **If all athletes on your team have not filled out this waiver, those athletes are not allowed to participate in the meet.**

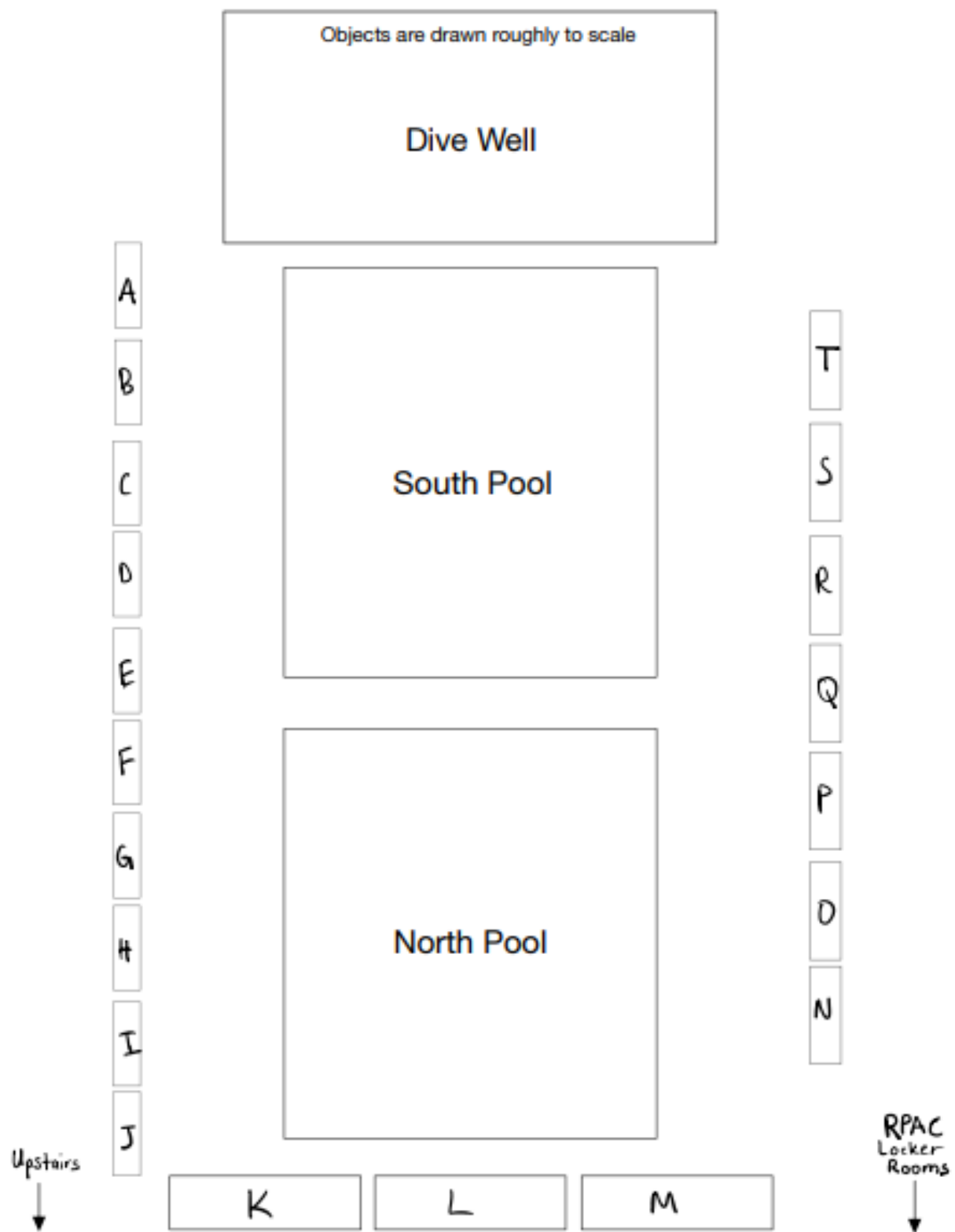

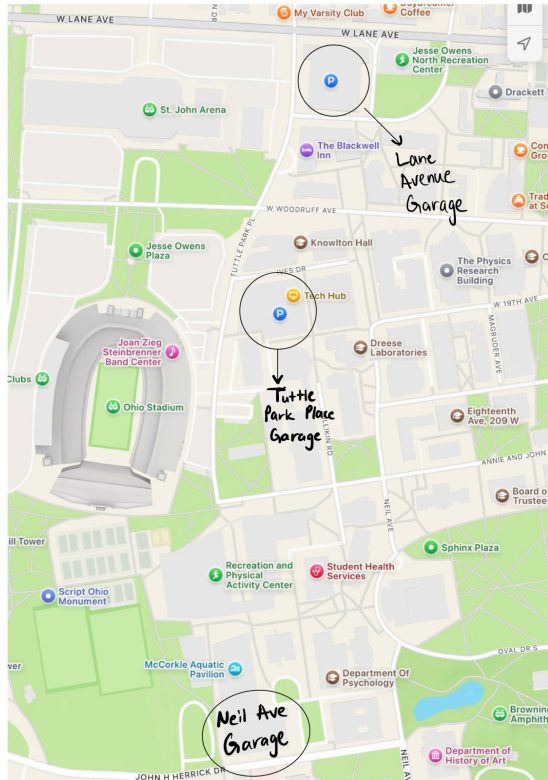
