




Presidents Handbook

Nationals Falsified Entry Times Investigation

What Started the Investigation?

 Growing popularity of Nationals, Increased waitlist numbers, disproportionate number of swimmers adding significant amounts of time at Nationals

What Was The Process?

- Over the summer, a subcommittee underwent a thorough review of times that added a significant % from seed time AND did not attain the 2025 NOT.
- Entry times were compared to known season and lifetime performances.
- Clubs with entries needing additional explanation were reached out to and given opportunity to explain and give context.

What Was Found?

- A number of clubs and individuals falsified entry times either through intrasquad meets or editing meet file submissions.
- All clubs involved in the investigation have been notified of their resolution or sanctions, except for a few outstanding cases.

Investigation Resolution

- CCS has and will always take competition integrity seriously
- The AB will continue to review entry times for Championship meets for legitimacy in the future
- Intrasquad meets are now no longer permitted for CCS NQTs or Record Recognition
- Future violations will have more severe sanctions imposed.

How you can help:

If you suspect an athlete or club is falsifying their time(s), you may make a confidential report by emailing
 <u>collegeclub@usmastersswimming.org</u>. All reports will be kept confidential, and all reporters will be protected
 by the CCS Whistleblower Policy.

CCS Rule Changes

Intrasquad meets are no longer sanctioned

- You can still host intrasquad meets, but they will not count for NQTs or be entered in the CCS database
- Suspension of Sanctioned Intrasquad meets is due to a large number of Falsified Times coming from Intrasquad meets
- Exceptions can be made under special circumstances by emailing collegeclub@usmastersswimming.org.

CCS Rule Changes

- CCS will not sanction meets on the same weekend as CCS Nationals, or CCS Regionals within the corresponding region.
 - Exceptions may be considered by the Advisory Board under special circumstances on a case-by-case basis by emailing <u>collegeclub@usmastersswimming.org</u>.

CCS Rule Reminders

- CCS IDs are required in results upon submission to CCS. No retroactive changes will be made.
- Officials are required for meet certification
 - Any certified body recognized by USMS may be used, no specific level of certification needed (i.e. Stroke and Turn, Starter, etc.)
 - You may certify an officer as a USMS stroke and turns official following instructions here:
 https://www.usms.org/volunteer-central/quide-to-local-operations/event-management/officials/training-and-certification/officials-certification-program
- Backstroke finish can be completely underwater
 - Stroke and turn rules must follow USMS guidelines.
- Athletes may not be removed from a clubs CCS Roster after February 1st or if they have competed in Regionals

Amateurism and Eligibility Policy Reminder

Better spells out who can register as a CCS athlete, compete at Regionals/Nationals

- Implemented last season ('24-'25)
- Goal is to keep College Club Swimming on an 'amateur playing field'
- Individual CCS Athletes may NOT:
 - Be on a varsity roster (or have been on a varsity roster at any time in the current academic year)
 - Be sponsored (for swimming purpose or performance)
 - Be on a National Team in last two years (example: Team USA)
 - Participate in professional swim circuits (examples: AQUA World Champs, ISL, Pro Swim Series)
- Read the full policy! Goes into more detail for individuals, clubs, and possible sanctions
- We are aware of possible NCAA/Conference changes. This policy will likely be tweaked in the future!

Meet Manager Backup File Results Submission (2.3.3)

Meet Manager Database Backup File is the required file when submitting meet results!

- Replaces traditional Meet Results zip file
- Easy switch for meet hosts, simply save a different file at the end of your meet to send to CCS
- Allows CCS to better verify that meet rules are being followed
- Email to <u>collegeclub@usmasterswimming.org</u> within 7 days of the event

Reminder: Pad/Plunger & Backup (automatic timing) OR Two+ Hand Timers (manual timing)

If manual timing: Enter the watch times in the backup columns and average out in final column

2025 Regional Championship Updates

- Meet Packet to be released tomorrow
- Format will be same as last year:
 - All meets will be Prelims/Finals (most will be 2 courses for Prelims)
 - Championship/Consolation Finals (number of athletes varies by site)
 - 200 FL/BK/BR, 400 IM, 500 FR, and 1000 FR will be Timed Finals in the Prelims Session
 - All relays will be timed finals in Finals Sessions
 - O A/B Relays, but only A Relays score
- Western Regionals: 1000 athlete entry cap and new registration process
 - Clubs will pre-register to reserve space for their athletes via the tentative attendance form
 - Athletes from the pre-registered clubs will then sign up for their events in the CCS portal
 - Review the meet packet for more information regarding this registration process

Regional Championships Reminder...

- If attending a Regionals site OUTSIDE of your assigned region...
 - Your club will compete as exhibition
 - Your swimmers are NOT eligible to...
 - Advance to Finals in Prelim/Final events
 - Score points
 - Set meet records



2026 CCS Nationals Qualifying Times

This year's qualifying times were determined by the Competition Committee using a systematic approach based on last year's qualifying times, entry times, and Nationals meet results.

Goals:

- 1. Decrease the number of athletes having to utilize the waitlist system to get into the meet.
- 2. Ensure fairness across events and genders (i.e. similar difficulty cuts across events).
- 3. Utilize previous years' data and statistical metrics to help predict qualifications.

2026 Relay Qualifying Times

Each club may enter a maximum of one (1) relay per relay event. To enter a relay for a given relay event, all of the following conditions must be met:

- 1) The relay must meet the 2026 NQT (except for the 4x50 Mixed Freestyle Relay)
- 2) The relay must be entered using the fastest time their club has competed as a relay in a sanction meet during the 2026 National Championship qualification period
- 3) The club must have qualified and entered four (4) swimmers of the same gender (ex: 4 women) into the meet OR is eligible for the 4th Relay Swimmer Exception Policy
