

# Emergency Action Plan

## Rescues and Submersions:

- Primary lifeguard blows three times and enters the water to obtain the victim
- Secondary lifeguard clears pool and assists primary if needed once pool is completely cleared
- An announcement can be made by office personnel to clear pool
- Office personnel becomes tertiary and assists primary and secondary lifeguard if needed
- Manager on duty calls 911. Manager on duty will wait for EMS to arrive in front of the building
- Manager on duty completes Incident Report

## Spine Board Procedure

- Primary lifeguard blows whistle three times and gently slides into the water
- Secondary lifeguard clears pool and prepares to assist the primary lifeguard
- Lifeguard or manager brings out spine board and assists with crowd control
- Office personnel or manager calls 911. Office personnel will wait for EMS to arrive in front of the building
- Primary lifeguard obtains in-line stabilization with the victim, bringing the victim towards the secondary lifeguard, who has the spine board ready in the pool
- The victim is placed on the spine board by the primary lifeguard. The secondary lifeguard is now responsible for in-line stabilization.
- The victim is secured to the spine board and staff awaits the arrival of EMS
- Manager on duty completes the incident report

## Emergency Response: phone number 810-299-4000

- Explain the type of injury and critical information (breathing, spinal injury, etc...)
- Give 911 operator the address of the pool:

- Answer any other questions the 911 Operator has and wait for the operator to hang up first
- Wait for EMS in front of the building

## First Aid

- As soon as the primary survey is completed, the victim is brought to the office if possible
- Lifeguards should always be wearing latex gloves during first aid
- Manager on duty completes Incident report

| Ventilation                           | Ventilation systems in buildings will continue to operate to design specifications. | Daily screeners                       | It remains the responsibility of families to conduct a daily self-screener. If the answer is “no” to all questions, no additional action is needed. If the answer is “yes”, you will keep your child home and notify the school.
