

One-Time Visitors

One-time visitors to our campus who will attend in-person events or activities must comply with the following safety requirements:

1. You are expected to comply with [safe on-campus behavior](#).
2. Please do not come to campus if you have had symptoms or a positive test in the past 10 days.
3. **Masks are no longer required for much of campus.** However, Masks are required to be [worn in classes, instructional labs, performance spaces, designated masking areas, healthcare settings, and on UMBC Transit](#). While masks are not generally required outdoors, some events and activities may require outdoor masking. Visitors should bring a mask with them or be prepared to obtain one on campus to visit areas/attend events with designated masking requirements.

Community members wishing to hold an event on campus should reach out to [Event and Conference Services](#) to understand space limitations and safety requirements.
