Location: Vigo Schools Aquatic Center – Voorhees Park

Aquatic Center: **Facility specifics:** 10 lanes, 50-meter long pool divided by 2 moveable bulkheads for 1 competition pool and 1 warm-up when the pool is configured in short course yards. When the pool is configured for long course meters, 9 lanes will be used for competition and one lane will be dedicated for warm up/warm down. Colorado Timing Systems electronic timing equipment and an LED matrix display board with video capabilities will be used.

The length of the competition course is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1, but as a bulkhead course, is subject to length confirmation. Eligibility of times for USMS Top 10 and records will be contingent on verification of bulkhead placement.

Water Depth: The water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3 ½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from the turn end is 6 ft. and at the start end is 6 ft.

The competition course has not been certified.

MEET FORMAT & ENTRIES

Format: All Events will be timed finals. The meet will be scored. All of the events will be in long course meters.

THT reserves the right to limit any event to adhere to the 4-hour rule to maintain a reasonable timeline. Flyover starts may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

A courtesy rest shall be given for swimmers in consecutive events. It is the responsibility of the coach or swimmer to notify the Meet Referee of a swimmer's situation PRIOR to the swimmer's first event regarding the courtesy.

The conduct of a sanctioned event shall be in strict compliance with applicable USMS swimming rules and administrative regulations, or when the sanctioned event is held simultaneously in conjunction with a USA Swimming sanctioned meet, with applicable USA Swimming rules and administrative regulations

Warmup lane assignments will be given to coaching staff prior to start of event. Coaches' meeting will be held via Zoom/WebEX on Wednesday, June 15, 2022 at 7:00PM EST. prior to the start of the event. Officials' meeting will be held 30 minutes prior to the start of each session.

Meet Entry Limits: The meet will be limited to the first 300 swimmers entered.

IE Entry Limits: 4 individual events per day (not including time trial events).

Relay Entry Limits: 2 relay events per day.

Entry Submission: Entries will be accepted beginning May 15, 2022 until the deadline of 5:00 PM EST on June 10, 2022. Deck entries will be permitted only if total limit per day has not been met, on a first come first serve basis until heats are filled, and only for new entries only. Deck entries will be \$10 each. Entries will be accepted from a Meet Manager file and should be emailed to entries@terrehautetorpedoes.com prior to the submission deadline. Teams must complete the entry form attached and submit it to the head table with payment.

USMS swimmers wishing to enter the meet should complete the forms at the end of this meet announcement and mail to the address provided.

Eligibility: Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming. Age as of June 17, 2022, will determine the swimmers age for the entire meet. Indiana Swimming does not process on-site registrations. All swimmers shall provide proof of current Masters membership acceptable to the LMSC. At the discretion of the meet director and exclusive of national championship meets, a swimmer may

enter indicating “number pending,” as long as proof of membership is presented prior to the swimmer’s participation in the event.

Entry Fees: \$25 entry fee per athlete (Includes admission for families, heat sheets and results on Meet Mobile*, cookout on Friday evening and \$2 ISI surcharge)
\$5 per individual timed/final event
\$8 per relay event
*Spectator Meet Mobile subscription for full access

Distance Events (1500 and 800): Swimmers participating in the 1500 and 800 must:

- Check in at the head table prior to Friday afternoon warm-ups
- Provide one timer and one counter to assist with the swimmer’s race

Awards: Individual High Point awards will be given to the highest point girl and boy swimmer in each age/gender division (10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, and 15+). Team trophies will be awarded to the top two teams, excluding THT.
Individual Events: 1st-3rd place will receive medals, 4th- 8th place will receive ribbons
Relay Events: 1st-3rd place will receive ribbons
Heat winners will receive a FREE popsicle.
Awards will NOT be mailed unless it is in error of THT.

Scoring: The top sixteen (16) finishers in each event will score.
Points will be awarded as follows:

Scratch Responsibility: All scratches for individual events must be made at the Head Table or through an email sent to entries@terrehautetorpedoes.com according to the following deadlines:

Friday evening: June 17, 2022 by 2:30 PM EST
Saturday: by the end of competition on June 17, 2022
Sunday: by the end competition on June 18, 2022

Clerk of Course: There will be a Clerk of Course located behind the diving boards for the 10 & Under Timed Final events (Sessions 4 and 6). All other swimmers report to the blocks for their events. It is the responsibility of the coach and swimmer to appear at the correct starting platform ready to swim in time for the start of his/her heat. Seeded heat sheets will be posted throughout the pool prior to the start of each session and available to coaches prior to the start of each session.

PARTICIPANT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Masters Swimming, Inc. ("USMS") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any USMS sanctioned or approved activity, including swimming camps, clinics, and exhibitions; learn-to-swim programs; swimming tryouts; fitness and training programs (including dryland training); swim practices and workouts (for both pool and open water); pool meets; open water competitions; local, regional, and national competitions and championships (both pool and open water); and related activities ("Event" or "Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement (the "Agreement");

1. I hereby certify and represent that (i) I am in good health and in proper physical condition to participate in the Events; and (ii) I have not been advised of any medical conditions that would impair my ability to safely participate in the Events. I agree that it is my sole responsibility to determine whether I am sufficiently fit and healthy enough to participate in the Events.
2. I acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of swimming. I understand that my participation involves risks and dangers, which include, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, sickness and disease, permanent disability, paralysis and death (from drowning or other causes); loss of or damage to personal property and equipment; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with natural or manmade objects; dangers arising from adverse weather conditions; imperfect water conditions; water and surface hazards; facility issues; equipment failure; inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the Event organizers; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks"). I understand that these Risks may be caused in whole or in part by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby expressly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any Events.
3. I agree to be familiar with and to abide by the Rules and Regulations established by USMS, including any safety regulations. I accept sole responsibility for my own conduct and actions while participating in the Events.
4. I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19, or other viral or bacterial infection, while participating in any of the Events, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I agree that if I have a fever, cough, feel short of breath, have any other symptoms, have knowingly been exposed to a communicable disease such as COVID-19 or have traveled to or from a highly impacted area, I will not attend an Event for at least two weeks after exposure or symptoms have subsided or I have returned from a highly impacted area. In addition, if I discover I have been exposed to a suspected or positive case of COVID-19 or have tested positive for COVID-19, I will notify the USMS coach or club administrator immediately.
5. I hereby Release, Waive and Covenant Not to Sue, and further agree to Indemnify, Defend and Hold Harmless the following parties: USMS, its members, clubs, workout groups, event hosts, employees, and volunteers (including, but not limited to, event directors, coaches, officials, judges, timers, safety marshals, lifeguards, and support boat owners and operators); the USMS Swimming Saves Lives Foundation; USMS Local Masters Swimming Committees (LMSCs); the Event organizers and promoters, sponsors and advertisers; pool facility, lake and property owners or operators hosting the Events; law enforcement agencies and other public entities providing support for the Events; and each of their respective parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies, officers, directors, partners, shareholders, members, agents, employees, and volunteers (individually and collectively, the "Released Parties"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorneys' fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.
6. I further agree that if, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities which any may be incurred as the result of such claim.

I hereby warrant that I am of legal age and competent to enter into this Agreement, that I have read this Agreement carefully, understand its terms and conditions, acknowledge that I will be giving up substantial legal rights by signing it (including the rights of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns), acknowledge that I have signed this Agreement without any inducement, assurance, or guarantee, and intend for my signature to serve as confirmation of my complete and unconditional acceptance of the terms, conditions and provisions of this Agreement. This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements, or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

RULES, POLICIES, AND RISK ASSUMPTION

Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming-member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into this meet. The swimmer's age as of July 24, 2021 shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet. Indiana Swimming does not process onsite memberships.

At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

The competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in USA Swimming Rule 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made of textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

Coaches and Officials MUST display their current USA Swimming coach credential or Deck Pass to gain deck access. The meet referee and/or meet director reserves the right to ask for coach credential or Deck Pass and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current.

The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in any changing area, restrooms, or locker rooms. Deck changes are prohibited. It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

COVID Risk Assumption

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.

USA Swimming, Inc., cannot prevent you (or your child(ren)) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in USA Swimming sanctioned events. It is not possible to protect against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to participate in a USA Swimming sanctioned event, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

By attending or participating in this competition, you voluntarily assume all risks associated with exposure to covid-19 and forever release and hold harmless USA swimming and Indiana swimming and each of their officers, directors, agents, employees or other representatives from any liability or claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claims you may have to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of covid-19 related to participation in this competition.

Safe Sport 360

The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 720-531-0340 or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after [insert date that is 30 days prior to the last date of the actual competition], who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after [insert same date], who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.
