

COVID-19 Statement: An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. Neither the DV LMSC, Upper Dublin School District nor U.S. Masters Swimming can prevent you (or your family) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in USMS Swimming sanctioned events. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to participate in a USMS sanctioned event, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19 by attending and/or participating in this event.

Masks/Spectator Space: Masks are recommended but not required. Masks are only required for youth and those working in youth programs. There will be a limited amount of bleachers so swimmers are asked to limit their spectators. Non-swimmers will be asked to remain in the bleachers and not come onto the pool deck unless they are actively participating in the running of the meet (announcing, timing, officiating, etc.).
