1650 yards, 1000 yards, 800 yard relay, 1500 meters, and 800 meter relay March 2 & 3, 2024, Oro Valley, Arizona

Eligibility: Any swimmer with a valid 2024 USMS registration. USMS will also offer a one-event membership for a fee of \$20. Times swum under one-event registration are not eligible for USMS Top 10 or records consideration. International entries must include a copy of the swimmer's World Aquatics recognized Masters Swimming registration card and fees in U.S. dollars. The online registration process will verify that each entrant has a valid 2024 USMS registration card; otherwise, a World Aquatics-recognized Masters Swimming card or one-event membership must be submitted. Failure to submit proof of registration will result in the entry being rejected. For further registration information, contact Larry John at Larry.JohnSBSC@gmail.com.

Rules: 2024 USMS rules apply. All events are timed finals. Due to the combination of yards and meters events, the age group will be based on the date of the swim for yards and December 31, 2024, for meters.

Swimmers who exceed the time limits for each event (1650: 60-minutes, 1000: 35-minutes, and the 1500: 60-minutes) will be stopped.

Timing: Split times may be requested in writing, and the request forms will be available at registration.

- Short course yards (1650, 1000, and 800 relay): The primary timing system will be automatic timing. Times may be submitted for USMS records and USMS Top 10 consideration.
- Long course meters (1500 and 800 relay): The primary timing system will be automatic timing. Times may be submitted for world records, USMS records, and USMS Top 10 consideration.

Seeding: All events will be seeded mixed men and women, fastest to slowest, based on entry times. Seed times must be current. They may be verified and adjusted by the meet director.

Lap Counters: Personnel will be provided for all swimmers in each of the individual events to count laps. If a swimmer prefers to use their own lap counter, they may.

Awards: Commemorative embroidered towels will be awarded to each male and female age-group winner based on the total time for all three events. Standard 5-year age groupings (60 – 64, etc.) based on age as of December 31, 2024. The "Conquistador" medal will be awarded to all swimmers completing all 3 events. There are no team awards.



Results: At the conclusion of the meet, results will be available through Club Assistant at www.swimphone.com

Entries and fees: Online registration only. Flat entry fee of \$30 per event or \$75 for all 3 events plus \$20 for non-USMS members for the one event membership. Those who register for at least one individual event may swim in a relay at no additional cost. Relay only fee is \$10 per relay per swimmer.

- Fee includes a meet T-shirt for participants entering all three individual events.
- Specify Women or Men T-shirt sizes during registration. To guarantee you will receive your specified size, register by February 17.
- Anyone with COVID-19-like symptoms cannot compete or enter the facility.

Entry Deadline: Online registration closes on Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at 11:59 pm.

Online registration only. No deck entries, mail, or fax entries will be accepted.

Facility: The Oro Valley Aquatic Center (OVAC) is located next to Canyon del Oro High School in the James D. Kriegh Park, 23 W. Calle Concordia, Oro Valley, AZ 85704. This is an outdoor 50-meter by 25-yard pool with non-turbulent lane lines, electronic timing, and without a bulkhead. The length of the competition course is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1.

The 1650-, 1000- and 800-relay-yard events will be competed in a 25-yard configuration with 10 competition lanes. The pool will be reconfigured to 50-meters with 8 competition lanes for the 1500 and 800-relay events. A 25-yard pool will be available for warm-up and cool-down during the meet.

Restrooms, drinking fountains, showers, and a changing area are available, but no lockers are available. Temperatures may vary significantly during the day, and sun protection (hats,

sunglasses, sunscreen) is recommended.



Location: Directions from I-10: Ina Rd. Exit #125, east on Ina to Oracle Rd., left (north) on Oracle to Calle Concordia, left (west) on Calle Concordia, pool is on your right in 1/4 mile. Parking lots are available directly west and east of the pool on Calle Concordia.

Accommodations: Numerous hotels are available in the Oro Valley, AZ, and Northwest Tucson, AZ region.

Climate: The climate in Oro Valley in March is typically sunny, with highs in the 70s and lows in the 40s.

Check-in: Swimmers may check in at SwimPhone.com beginning at 6 p.m. on March 1 or in person at the meet on March 2 and 3.
