A parliamentarian is a consultant who advises the presiding officer and other officers, committees, and members on matters of parliamentary procedure. Parliamentarians are frequently used to assist with procedure during House of Delegate and board meetings.

Key responsibilities

- Be able to clearly explain governing rule and/or meaning of vote about to be taken
- Must be present at all HOD meetings and be attentive to proposal/floor discussion.
