National One-Hour Swim

It's time again! The 4th Annual National One-Hour Swim Championships are set for January, 1981. This postal event, sanctioned by the Potomac Valley Association of the AAU and sponsored by the D.C. Masters, is open to any AAU registered Master athlete, or Master athlete registered with a similar body in his or her own country.

Postal meets, though they lack the thrill of head-to-head competition and the

accompanying camaraderie, permit everyone to compete in a major event without the expense of travel. Also they can be done on one's own time. For these reasons the National One-Hour Swim has become a very popular event -- this year more than a thousand entries are expected.

The object of the contest is to determine who can swim the greatest distance in one hour. The person swimming the farthest is declared the winner, the person swimming the second farthest is awarded second place, etc. In the event that two or more swimmers complete the same distance, a tie is declared.

Each swimmer is required to find a lap counter, timer and starter to ensure that every effort is made to accurately count the number of laps he or she swims. All distances are rounded off to the last completed five yard increment.

The month of January is the time more swimmers are starting their initial training for the short course season -- and that means overdistance training. What better way for Masters competitors to invigorate their endless early season laps than to train for and enter the 1981 National One-Hour Swim? And what a nice way for fitness and lap swimmers to be able to test themselves in the pool against other swimmers without the pressures of a swimming meet environment?

Team: The team shall be composed of three swimmers in the following age groups: 25+, 35+, 45+, 55+, 65+ and 75+, for both men and women. The youngest member determines the age of the team. No unattached or mixed teams allowed, and all members of a team must be associated with the same AAU registered club or team.

AWARDS: Individual: AAU Masters Championship Medals will be awarded to the first six place winners in each age group and sex.

Team: Each member of the first three teams in each age group and sex will be awarded AAU Masters Championship Medals.

EVENT: The object of the contest is to determine who can swim the greatest distance in one hour. The person swimming the farthest will be declared the winner, the person swimming the second farthest will be awarded second place, etc. In the event that two or more swimmers complete the same distance, a tie will be declared.

Each swimmer will be required to provide his/her own lap counter, timer and starter to ensure that the "Lap Counter/Distance Computer" is properly used. Every effort must be made to count accurately the number of laps. All distances are to be rounded off to the last completed five yard increment.

In the team event, a team shall be composed of three swimmers; the team with the highest combined cumulative total for the three swimmers' distances shall be declared the winner.
