Comments on 1994 1 Mile Championship in Cleveland, Ohio:

The race was well organized with perfect weather and the obvious dedication of Ohio Masters, including Maureen Koss (Chairperson), Doug Brogan (Manager) and Pieter Cath (Registrar/Scoring). Particularly praiseworthy were the ample food and drinks after the race--pizza, banana bread, bagels, Power Bars, bananas, soft drinks and water. Also, the information sheet handed out to each swimmer (attached) was a good idea.

The only negative comment I heard involved difficulty in seeing the buoys during the second half of the race. In that direction at that time of day, the sun was in the eyes of the competitors, and a few more buoys would have helped. I do not consider this to have been a major problem, and in fact, I personally was able to see the buoys in spite of the sun.

The turnout (45) was disappointing, not the least to the organizers, with several age groups having just one competitor. This was largely due to a major triathlon being held in Cleveland the same day.

Finally, while not USMS requirements, Ohio Masters might consider two small changes for future races:

- a. Swim caps color coded by age group. This allows swimmers to identify their competition in the water.
- b. A list of entrants by age group distributed prior to the race. This had been prepared but copies were not available.

The bottom line is that I thoroughly enjoyed the race and believe Ohio Masters should be considered for future championships.
