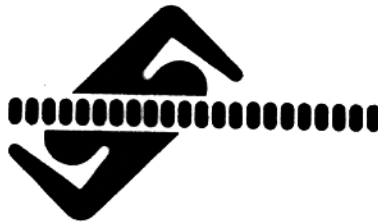

# 1995 United States Masters Swimming 3.5 Mile Open Water National Championships

## Fort Lauderdale, Florida

- DATE:** Monday, May 22, 1995
- TIME:** Check-In 7:30 a.m.  
Race Start 9:00 a.m.
- LOCATION:** The Atlantic Ocean along Fort Lauderdale Beach, directly in front of the International Swimming Hall of Fame.
- COURSE:** The course is rectangular and the race will begin with an in-water start approximately 50 yards from shore. Swimmers will proceed south for .25 miles, turn east for 50 yds., turn north for 1.75 miles, turn west for 50 yds., turn south for 1.5 miles, ending at the starting point. There will be one feeding station located at the 2 mile mark. The ocean temperature will be approximately 79-84 degrees, surf conditions moderate (1-3 feet) with the prevailing winds out of the SE.
- RULES:** 1995 USMS Rules and Regulations will govern this event. For safety reasons, swimmers who cannot complete the 3.5 mile course in 3 hours are advised not to enter. Swimmers on the course after 3 hours will be stopped and ruled as DNF (did not finish). There will be no escorts allowed during the race and the use of wet suits is prohibited.
- ELIGIBILITY:** The race is open to all swimmers currently registered with United States Masters Swimming or their nation's recognized masters swimming organization.
- ENTRIES:** Entries must be received by May 8, 1995. There will be no entries accepted on the day of the race. A COPY OF EACH SWIMMER'S 1995 USMS REGISTRATION CARD OR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL PERMIT MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM. Entries received without a copy of their 1995 card or marked "pending" will be deemed incomplete and returned. There will be no team event for this race.
- ENTRY FEES:** Entry fee for this event is \$20.00 (U.S.) per individual. This includes race packet, swim cap, pre-race fruit and beverage, and post-race meal.
- AWARDS:** Medals will be given to the top three finishers in each age group (19-24, 25-29, 30-34 and so on) for both male and female. USMS National Championship Patches will be awarded to all individual first place finishers.
- SAFETY:** Safety craft will patrol the course and stationed at each turn. Manned lifeguard towers are located every 250 yards along the beach. A feeding station will be located at the final turn. Swim caps that are provided must be worn.
- T-SHIRTS:** T-shirts will be sold on race day for \$10 each while they last.
- LODGING:** The Doubletree - Oceanside will serve as the Headquarters Hotel for this event at \$79 per night. It is located directly across the street from the race start. For reservations, please call 305-524-8733 and mention the Masters Open Water Swim. Remember that the USMS National Short Course Championships will have just concluded on the previous evening and rooms may be limited.
