Directions to Marguerite Aquatics Complex

From the 5 Freeway exit La Paz Road (89). Use the left 2 lanes (if coming from 5 south, and 2 right lanes if coming from north 5) to turn east onto La Paz Road. Travel approximately 1.1 miles on La Paz Road and use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto Marguerite Parkway. Go approximately 1.8 miles and turn right onto Casta Del Sol. In approximately 350 feet make a right into the parking lot.


Parking

Off-site parking and FREE Shuttle Service

- The shuttle pick-up/drop off is on Marguerite Parkway, outside the gate at the south end of the 50m pool.
- Off-site parking is at Marty Russo Youth Athletic Park: 22056 Olympiad Road, Mission Viejo, CA.
 - The parking shuttle will run on a loop from 7:00 AM until 30 minutes after completion of the last heat of the last event from Wednesday, August 21 through Sunday, August 25.
- The shuttle leaves Marty Russo Park every hour at 7:00 AM, 8:00 AM, 9:00 AM, 1:00 PM, etc.
- The shuttle leaves Marguerite Aquatics Complex every hour on the :30 (7:30 AM, 8:30 AM, 9:30 AM, 1:30 PM etc.)
