- How far can you swim in an hour?
- Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> place.
- Historically more participants.
- Relays (3M, 3F, 2F+2M, same club); yardage added.
- Team scores = Individual yardage added for members of same USMS club.



### **All About ePostal National Championships**

### 5K/10K and 3000/6000-Yard ePostal National Championships

- Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Relays (3M, 3F, 2F+2M, same club); times added.
- Team Scores = Quality points added for members of same USMS club.
- Quality Points = Record time/Your time x 1000.
- New records score over 1000 quality points.


