Pre-Annual Meeting

Virtual Schedule Manager

<u>The 2022 Annual Meeting virtual calendar</u> allows attendees to explore meetings and sessions, build their own agenda, register for meetings, learn about speakers, and discover who will be attending sessions.

It is recommended that attendees <u>sign up for an account</u> and use it to login to Sched to bookmark your favorites, indicate your plans to attend, sync meeting details to your phone and/or calendar. This will allow USMS to record attendance and you to <u>discover who'll be attending</u>, learn about speakers, and more.

Attendees can choose their preferred time zone, <u>use this guide to explore the Sched functionality</u> (calendar defaults to EDT otherwise). For those attending the sessions of the House of Delegates in person, the time zone in Denver, CO is Mountain Daylight Time (MDT) - please note the appropriate meeting times for your specific time zone.

Hotel Reservations

USMS will be making all hotel reservations and will send out confirmation numbers to those attending, in addition to their reservation details. (Room type and check in and out dates) Check in is at 3PM MDT and check out is at 12PM MDT.

We appreciate the LMSCs making reasonable efforts to submit roommate preferences that have already confirmed they are comfortable sharing a room. All submitted roommate requests have been assigned as requested.

Important Items to Bring

Plenty of patience and an open mind.

Required - A laptop, tablet, or smartphone, with the ability to connect to Zoom and Wi-Fi.

Due to the hybrid nature (in-person and virtual participation) of the 2022 Annual Meeting, we will be using the Zoom Webinar functionality for the House of Delegates (HOD), as we've done the past two years.

Customized links for each HOD session will be sent directly to all voting delegates, regardless of their attendance preference. All delegates will need to sign into the session with their customized link to:

- 1. Receive the election ballot via Zoom polling.
- 2. Vote on legislative proposals.
- 3. Certify their attendance.

The meeting rooms will be Wi-Fi accessible and charging stations will be available. It is highly recommended that delegates sign up for an account and use it to log in to Zoom to ensure they are fully able to participate in the hybrid meeting.

The <u>Delegate orientation and USMS Townhall, Tuesday August 30, 8:30pm - 9:30pm EDT</u>, will be a webinar to learn more about how the annual meeting will run and to gain experience and training on Zoom.

A refillable water bottle

Before your trip to Denver, "The Mile High City", and while you're at the annual meeting, drinking plenty of water is the number one way to help your body adjust easily to the higher altitude. The low humidity in Colorado keeps the air dry, like the desert, so you need about twice as much water as you would drink at home.

What to Wear

Be comfortable

- Welcome reception and daily sessions business-casual or casual clothes -- a sweater or jacket may be needed.
- Reception and Dinner Saturday night we'd recommend "Dressy Casual".

Located in the Airport Terminal - the hotel is conveniently located just steps from the main terminal at the Denver International Airport, which ensures a seamless arrival and departure.

COVID Mitigation Protocols

USMS is monitoring the COVID situation in Denver and nationally and planning accordingly. We're working with the Westin Denver International Airport to ensure the annual meeting will be as safe as possible for our attendees. Marriott has rolled out its Commitment to Clean program that's committed to providing a safe environment for both staff and guests.

The protocols below are the current plan but could change as we get closer to the annual meeting:

- Vaccinations and boosters
 - Strongly recommended for all attendees.
- Masking
 - Masks are no longer required at The Westin Denver regardless of vaccination status. The hotel is on airport property, so masking rules will be the same as when travelling and are subject to change.
 - The safety of our guests and associates is a top priority. As guidance regarding face coverings and vaccination verification varies by local jurisdiction and may change, guests should review public information websites for the most up-to-date guidance for your destination, as well as the hotel-specific sections and <u>US and Canada Travel Advisories | Marriott Bonvoy™</u> before traveling.
 - Fully vaccinated guests are no longer required to wear face coverings or social distance in indoor or outdoor areas of the hotel, unless required by local law.
- Negative COVID-19 test
 - All attendees are asked to test within 72 hours of attending Relay.
 - You won't need to show proof of a negative test, but we ask in the name of our volunteers, staff, and your own health that you stay home if you test positive.
