## Introduction

The Northwest Zone covers an area of 1,175,954 square miles which includes all of Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and 3 counties in Nevada. There are seven LMSCs as Idaho, Oregon, Washington, and part of Nevada combine to form 4 of them: Inland Northwest (IW), Oregon (OR), Pacific Northwest (PN), and Snake River (SR).

The NW Zone currently lists 88 USMS members serving on the LMSC's leadership teams. The board conducts Zoom calls in December, March, June and prior to the USMS Annual Meeting. 19 zone members are expected to attend in person and 4 others will attend virtually. As of July 31, the zone has 3,953 members (within 1% of the previous year) and 45 clubs. Snake River is the smallest LMSC with 98 members and Pacific Northwest is the largest with 1,659 members. The Zone publishes a newsletter four times a year. It is posted on the Zone website: www.northwestzone.org.

## **Discussions and Projects Since Last Annual Meeting**

- Bids were approved for the following zone 2023 zone championships:
  - SCY Blue Wave Aquatics hosted on April 15 & 16 in Federal Way, WA.
  - 1500m OW hosted by COMA on July 29 at Elk Lake, OR. Sadly, the event was cancelled due to smoke from nearby fires.
  - LCM hosted by The Dalles Masters Swim Team August 5, 2023 at The Dalles, OR.
- New Zone Webmaster, Dave Cabrey, has made significant improvements to the zone's website. He worked with previous webmaster Hugh Moore and website developer Matt Miller to obtain all transfers to his name and the NW Zone.
- Zone records in SCY, SCM and LCM courses have been kept up to date by Steve Darnell. After Steve records any new records, they are then posted to the website.
- The Zone voted to reinstitute the membership surcharges of \$.50/swimmer as of 5/1 of each year. These funds were billed and collected for 2022 and 2023.

# Oceana Zone

## Introduction

The Oceana Zone includes the Pacific and Hawaii LMSCs. From one end to the other the zone is over 2,700 miles, the greatest end to end distance of any zone. The zone committee meets annually during the USMS Annual Meeting and conducts other business, as needed, by phone, email or a virtual program such as Zoom. This year, as in 2022, the meeting will be conducted on a virtual (Zoom) platform as part of an overall hybrid approach to the 2023 USMS Annual meeting.

## **Discussions and Projects Since Last Annual Meeting**

- 1. As of 7/25/2023 there are 9,306 USMS members in the Pacific LMSC compared with 9,736 members at the same point in 2022 (a slight decrease of approximately 4%). In Hawaii, as of 7/25/2023 there are 510 USMS members compared with 403 members at the same point in 2022 (an increase of approximately 27%).
- 2. **Pacific LMSC**: We welcomed a new event host and some returning host for pool events. Thank you to Sacramento Masters, Clovis Masters and Vacaville swim club and all the other usual hosts of our swim events. We will have a full slate of open water events in 2023. We are finalizing the program for our Annual Celebration in November. We will also be electing new officers for the next two years at this year's meeting.
- 3. Hawaii LMSC: 2023 has been a time when Masters swim programs throughout Hawaii have been resuming and growing now that COVID-19 is mostly in our rear- view mirrors. Pool access has been a major concern for several clubs.

After learning about some of the struggles that our Hawaii clubs were experiencing and after reviewing our Hawaii LMSC's finances, we decided to offer grants to the clubs to help with expenses such as equipment purchases and pool rental fees. The grants available to each club were calculated proportionately, based on the number of USMS registered swimmers in each club in March 2023. The total grant pool was \$20,000. We are continuing to distribute these grants to some of the late-comers to the program. This grant program is a one-year program, available only in 2023.

We are planning to hold our HI - LMSC 2023 Annual Meeting after the national meeting in September. Our goal for this meeting (in addition to elections of officers) is to inform USMS members in Hawaii about any upcoming opportunities for coach trainings, swim meets and events that are planned for 2024.

The cost of transportation between the Hawaiian Islands and also to the U.S. Mainland continues to be an impediment for Hawaii's USMS swimmers to participate in statewide and national swim meets. We will be considering ways to help swimmers overcome this impediment in 2024.

We have provided text and photos to USMS to update our HI LMSC website. We've been told that the updates will be completed by this fall.
