

An information hub for all USMS volunteer resources. This is a great starting point for new volunteers, as all role requirements, documents, and resources are easily accessible.





A calendar of events for national and local volunteers, inclusive of important dates and deadlines throughout the calendar year.








# **USMS Community Forums**

#### Like Reddit, for Masters Swimming!

A social platform where volunteers can connect, exchange information, ask questions, and support one another. The Community Forums are a place for volunteers to seek out specific advice and discover ideas from volunteers across the country.

# Peer-to-peer volunteer groups
