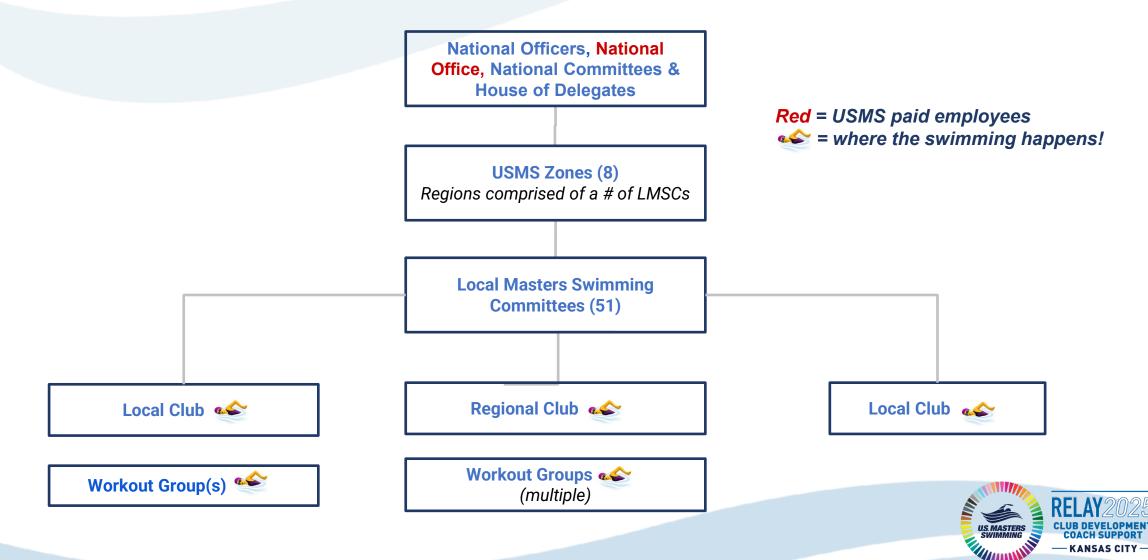

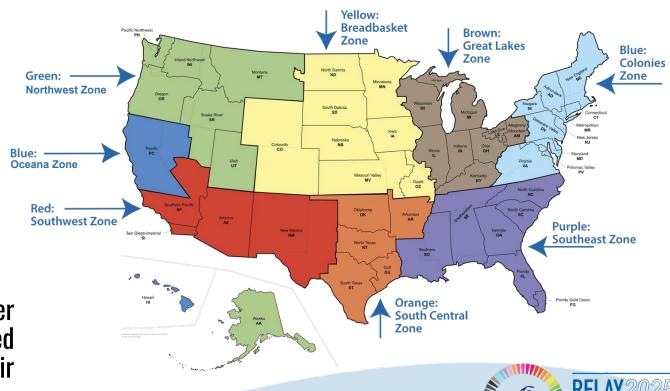


USMS Regional Leadership Zones

All Local Masters Swimming Committees (LMSCs) within USMS are grouped into *eight* distinct regional Zones.

- Breadbasket Zone
- Colonies Zone
- Great Lakes Zone
- Northwest Zone
- Oceana Zone
- South Central Zone
- Southeast Zone
- Southwest Zone

Each Zone is overseen by a **Zone Chair**, another volunteer role within USMS. Zone Chairs are elected every two years by LMSC leadership within their respective Zones.

LMSCs exist to support the local needs of clubs and members by offering club support, promoting/hosting events, and advancing USMS initiatives.
